Intro.	<p>There are two key pieces to being a successful photographer. The first is being able to see the photographic opportunities in everyday events and places. The second is the unique ability to take a verbal (or written) statement and reflect it in a photographic image. This assignment will test both of these skills.</p>
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Assignment	<p>For this assignment you are required to have a camera with you throughout the course of an entire day and you have to take a picture every 20 minutes (+/- 3 minutes). The resulting series of photographs should give us a solid representation of this particular day (12 hours) in your life.</p> <p>However, that is not all. The second part of this assignment is you are required to Journal every photograph along the way. Each journal entry should have two parts: <i>Part 1: What were you feeling, seeing, doing at the time</i> <i>Part 2: What photographic considerations did you take to represent what you stated in Part 1</i></p>
