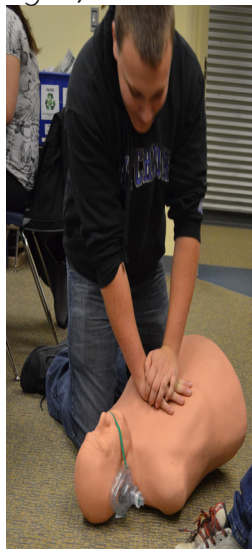


# HEALTH OCCUPATIONS

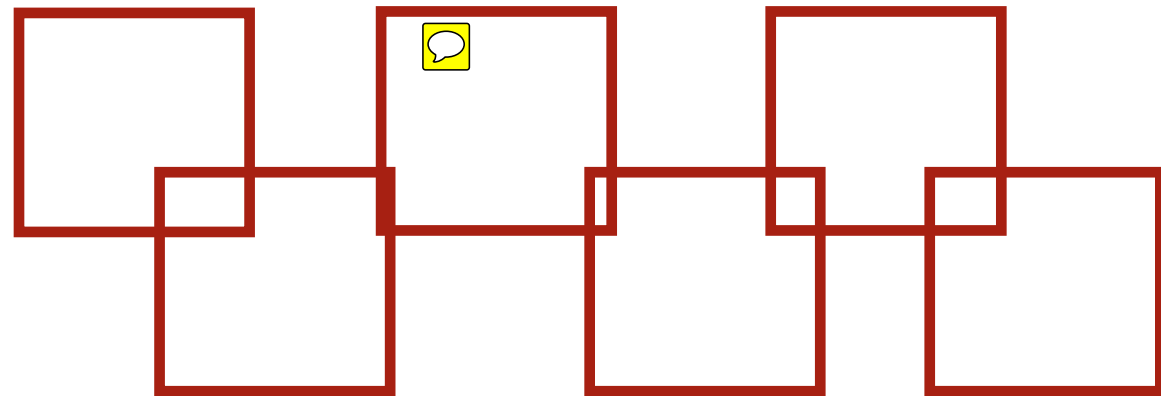
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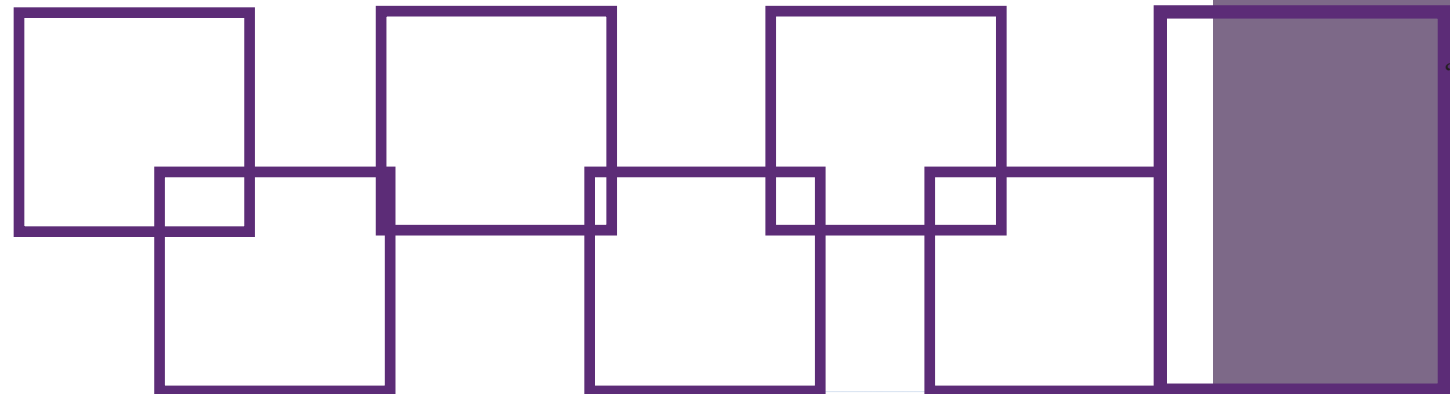
This year our school got a brand new lab. Remember where the weight room used to be? If you walk past it now, it's the new health room all set up and ready to use.
