Boone County Park's Celebrating 40 Years of Service

The Boone County Parks and Recreation Department will celebrate 40 years of serving the community on August 12, 2012. We started out with 20 acres and only 2 employees. Today, 40 years later, we have approximately 2,000 acres of land with 16 full-time and around 130 seasonal employees.

Boone County Parks has come very far since 1972. We were honored as the Outstanding Department for 2000 and 2009 at the Kentucky Recreation and Park Society (KRPS) conference, an award given to only one department in the state. During 2009 we had 31,089 participants that registered in programs. The number continues to increase as we offer new programs like Zumba, Star Gazing and Dinosaur Day with Dad.

Our dedicated staff and supportive community has always been a factor in the Parks' success. Our past directors have been inducted into the KRPS Hall of Fame for their accomplishments and have also received Professional of the Year and the Fellow Award for KRPS. Current Program Planners have been recognized as Professionals of the Year and Fellow Awards for their outstanding contributions to the field of Parks and Recreation. We were also awarded Outstanding Program 2010 from KRPS for our "Search for Tom Turkey" program.

Over these four decades our program planners have come up with ideas for programs that have lasted through the years and have become local family traditions. These include Touch-a-Truck Day, Boone Woods Arts and Crafts Show, Jack-o-Lantern Walk and Breakfast with Santa. Parents can see their children participate in the same summer parks programs as they did growing up with activities like Tee-ball and Archery. Boone County Parks has been there for family reunions, birthdays and other celebrations of the community for a long time now, offering shelters to reserve with picnic tables and a scenic view. Newer programs are quickly becoming more popular, with hundreds taking advantage of Family Movie Night at the parks, or summer camps at Erpenbeck, North Pointe and Goodridge Elementary.

Since 1978, young athletes are given a chance to compete with peers in competitions like Pitch Hit and Run, Punt Pass and Kick, and Hershey Track and Field Youth Program. Based on their performance, participants can advance to regional and then national levels. A large number of our Boone County athletes have been named National Finalists in every one of these competitions. We have 35 baseball fields and 18 soccer fields with over 6,000 participants using them yearly.

Our England-Idlewild Park Disc Golf Course has been recognized as one of the best courses in the nation, receiving five-star ratings and putting Boone County on the map. The Kentucky State Disc Golf Championships have been held at the course since 2005. There is even a YouTube video that was made about the golf course, calling it "one of the best disc golf courses in the world."

We have grown from 2 parks to 19 parks, just recently attaining the 74-acre Boone Cliffs and 107-acre Dinsmore Woods property. The Parks Department acquired these two parks from the Nature Conservancy in 2010, and encourages the public to explore the trails, high cliffs and vast variety of bird species and trees.

The Boone County Parks is still continuing to grow. In coordination with the Boone Conservancy, we have transformed an old gravel pit off Burlington Pike into a brand new park. Three years in the making, Conservancy Park is planned to open on April 27th. It will have a fishing lake, shelter and walking trails for the community to enjoy.

Boone County Parks has strived to create quality programs and events for our community.

Walton Community Park Renovations & Upgrades

The City of Walton, Walton City Council's Park Committee and the Boone County Parks Department are proud to announce the Walton Community Park Renovations and Upgrades.

Walton Community Park is a 30 acre facility located at 35 Old Stephenson-Mill Road. The park already consisted of 3 large shelters, ball fields, playgrounds, walking trails and much more. The renovations and upgrades to Walton Community Park have included a new playground, a 9 hole Disc Golf Course, repaved parking lot, new water fountains and a Dog Park which includes three separate runs.

The future will bring more renovations & upgrades to Walton Park.

New Conservancy Park to open in April

The Boone Conservancy and the Boone County Parks Department are proud to announce the opening of The Conservancy Park Belleview.

The Boone Conservancy is a non–profit organization dedicated to the creation of parks and protection of land with unique or significant recreational, natural, scenic, historical and/or cultural value.

The Boone Conservancy undertook the reclamation of an old abandoned gravel mine working with KY Department of Mine Reclamation and Enforcement. The park consists of over 45 acres of land. The Conservancy Park Belleview will offer a walking trail, shelter, fishing and much more. Park development, operation and maintenance will be provided by the Boone County Parks & Recreation Department.



Boone County Parks is excited to bring back Camp Goodridge, Camp North Pointe, Camp Erpenbeck and to introduce Camp Yealey. These camps are programs that help working families make permanent, affordable summer arrangements for their children. At each camp, each day is broken into age appropriate activities and opportunities for your child to learn & grow in a fun, positive environment. CITs will learn how to be a counselor

in their "separate activities."

The camps run 9 weeks, June 4 - August 3, 7:00 am to 5:30 pm. Start date is not officially set until all snow days are accounted for.



NEW Boone County drop-off recycling program

As of November 1, the Boone County Public Works took over the county recycling drop-off program. There are changes to the program, residents are now responsible for sorting their own recyclables, but by doing this it will help save us time sorting and allows more recyclables to be collected in a shorter period of time. This will save time and MONEY!! We NO LONGER accept glass items in the recycling program. I know this is frustrating for many, but we have no way to process glass and no one is willing to buy glass items. We are still searching for solutions to this issue. However, you can take your glass to the Rumpke recycling drop-off site in Florence across from Goodwill.

There have been a few issues, but we are making progress. Last spring we had a total of six bins in which we were paying a local hauler over \$50,000 a year to haul to the recycler. Now we no longer have to pay for this service, and that is money saved for the Boone County taxpayers.

Boone County is paying for this with a grant received from the Kentucky State Division of Solid Waste Management in the sum of \$177,000. We were able to purchase 18 new recycling roll-offs, a trailer, baler, scale and a forklift. The Boone County inmates work sorting and baling the material for resale. Also, we now have recycling roll-offs at the Boone County schools and other locations for drop-offs.
